## A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALPARAISO, INDIANA, GRANTING MEMORIAL HEALTH SYSTEMS, LLC, A SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT A CONCEPT PLAN FOR CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY

WHEREAS, on August 13, 2007, the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, adopted Ordinance No. 30-2007 which rezoned certain property located within the City and owned by Memorial Health Systems, LLC, as a Medical, Office and Technology Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, Section 4010 B2 of the City's Zoning Ordinance (which was in effect at the time of the adoption of Ordinance No. 30-2007) provided that the rezoning of the aforementioned property would terminate if no concept plan for the property was submitted to the City within eighteen (18) months of the adoption of Ordinance No. 30-2007; and

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2009, the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, adopted Resolution No. 1-2009, granting Memorial Health Systems, LLC, an extension of two (2) years in which to submit a concept plan for the aforementioned property; and

WHEREAS, the City received a letter from Memorial Health Systems, LLC's, Chief Financial Officer requesting a second two (2) year extension of time to submit a concept plan for the property; and

WHEREAS, economic conditions have existed since the adoption of Ordinance No. 30-2007, which have made it difficult to develop the property on the anticipated schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, as follows:

- 1. The Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, hereby grants Memorial Health Systems, LLC, a second extension of time up to and including **January 20, 2012**, in which to submit the required concept plan for the property; and
- 2. In the event that the required concept plan is not submitted to the City on or before **January 20**, **2012** the zoning of the property shall revert to its previous designation.
