

RESOLUTION #6, 2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALPARAISO, INDIANA, ADOPTING THE STATE ROAD 49 CORRIDOR PLAN AS AN ADDENDUM TO THE 2030 ENVISION VALPARAISO COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Valparaiso, Indiana’s (“City”) current 2030 Envision Valparaiso Comprehensive Plan was adopted by the Common Council of the City in the form of Resolution No. 10, 2013 respectively; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to enhance the visual quality, access and safety of the State Road 49 corridor as an addendum to the EnVision Valparaiso 2030 Comprehensive Plan. The City has developed a State Road 49 Corridor Plan that will serve as a guide for future development , planning guidance, physical design direction for urban growth and development, regional change and environmental management of the State Road 49 corridor; and

WHEREAS, the State Road 49 Corridor Plan has been developed pursuant to Indiana Code IC 36-7-4-500 Series Comprehensive Plans and the Corridor Plan is hereby incorporated by reference into this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, extensive discussions were held with the general public and other interested parties concerning the proposed State Road 49 Corridor Plan and a formal public hearing was held by the City’s Plan Commission on April 14th, 2014 as part of the process of developing the plan; and

WHEREAS, following the aforementioned public hearing, the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, Plan Commission voted to recommend the approval of the State Road 49 Corridor Plan and officially certify its decision to the Common Council of the City by a 7-0 vote on April 14th, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Porter County, Indiana, as follows:

1. The City of Valparaiso’s State Road 49 Corridor Plan is hereby adopted as an addendum to the 2030 EnVision Valparaiso Comprehensive Plan.
