# VALPARAISO REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION Regular Meeting Minutes June 13, 2024

The regular meeting of the Valparaiso Redevelopment Commission was called to order at 4:10 p.m. on Thursday, June 13, 2024. Vice President Barbara Domer presided.

Members present were: Trish Sarkisian, Barbara Domer, Robert Cotton, Bill Durnell and Frank Dessuit. Also present were Director of Development George Douglas, City Attorney Patrick Lyp, Engineering Director Max Rehlander, and members of the public. Rob Thorgren was not in attendance.

### **ITEM #1- MINUTES: (3:18)**

Ms. Domer reported copies of the May 9, 2024, regular meeting minutes were distributed to members for their review prior to the meeting. After reviewing the minutes, all seemed in order. Ms. Domer recommended the approval of both the May 9<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes and the June 13<sup>th</sup> Executive meeting minutes.

Motion: Mr. Cotton stated the May 9, 2024, meeting minutes were reviewed and moved to approve them. Mr. Durnell seconded. A voice vote was unanimously carried.

Motion: Mr. Cotton moved to approve the Executive meeting Minutes. Mr. Durnell seconded. A voice vote was unanimously carried.

#### ITEM #2 CLAIMS REGISTER AND FINANCIAL REPORT: (3:43)

Mr. Douglas reported that the Commission was sent the June 2024 Claims Registers and May Financial Report prior to the meeting.

Ms. Domer asked questions about the EV charging station location. Mr. Douglas provided answers to the questions.

Mr. Cotton asked questions regarding the lobbying fees for Barnes & Thornburg. Mr. Douglas and Attorney Lyp provided answers to each of the questions.

Mr. Durnell asked a question regarding the relocation expenses for 359 Lincolnway and a utility box reimbursement. Mr. Douglas answered each of the questions.

Mr. Durnell asked a question regarding interest income and investments with Trust Indiana on the financial report and Mr. Douglas answered his question.

Motion: Mr. Durnell motioned to approve the June Register and May Financial Report. Mr. Cotton seconded the motion. A voice vote was unanimously carried.

#### ITEM #3 STAFF REPORT FOR EVANS AVE PAVING IMPROVEMENTS: (13:05)

Mr. Rehlander stated bids were opened for the local streets package on May 10, 2024. Evans Ave was part of the package and a summary of the cost for the improvements was provided. Mr. Rehlander stated that a portion of Evans Ave. is in the county, and they will pay for the paving to their portion of the project. The improvements came in at \$370,403.90 to be paid by the Redevelopment Commission.

Ms. Domer asked questions about the change in projected costs and appropriations for paving to be paid by the Redevelopment Commission. Mr. Rehlander answered each of the questions.

Mr. Durnell asked a question about the budget process and appropriation process and if they are one in the same. Mr. Douglas stated the process will be starting earlier this year. The process will start with the administration and department heads as with past budgets. Mr. Douglas will work toward a draft of the budget for the commission to review in August/September.

#### **ITEM #4 WEBSITE UPDATE: (23.26)**

Ms. Melcic gave a presentation addressing the updates made to the Redevelopment Commission website. Ms. Melcic informed the Commission that both her and George will meet with Emily Reyna to discuss the possibility of an interactive map for all Redevelopment Commission projects. Ms. Melcic expressed appreciation to the Commission members for their feedback and suggestions on improving the functionality and information provided on the website.

#### ITEM #5 OTHER BUSINESS: (28:43)

Mr. Douglas stated there is a sculpture unveiling at the Skate Park at 4:30 and weather pending may be moved inside.

#### ITEM #6 PUBLIC COMMENT: (29:47)

Mr. Ron Morey, 960 West St asked questions about the timeline for the sidewalk program on West St. Mr. Morey stated he has been to meetings about the sidewalks and curbs and some of the work has been done. Mr. Morey stated a curb was put in, in a strange spot and it has been hit at least 9 times. He stated there have been drainage issues for quite a while. His driveway has been affected by the water and the red color that is in the water. Mr. Morey stated the City has gone out to look at his concerns. He is also concerned about the timeline of when the work will be done on the streets and sidewalks on West St.

Mr. Douglas stated the RFQ responses are under review by impacted departments, and once a firm has been selected, an update will be provided.

### ITEM #7 ADJOURNMENT: (36:54)

Staff said they had no further items for the Commission's consideration. Mr. Cotton motioned to adjourn the meeting with Mr. Durnell seconding. A voice vote was unanimously carried. The June 13, 2024, Redevelopment Commission meeting adjourned at 4:43 p.m.

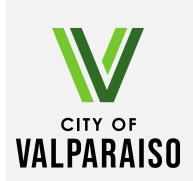

The City of Valparaiso, Indiana requests statement of qualifications for professional engineering and planning services related to the corridor study of West St. and Marsh St. The proposed project area will connect to Campbell St./Horseprairie Ave. and the proposed re-alignment currently in design from Journeyman to U.S. Hwy. 30. The project will then go west along West St. to the termini at U.S. 30 by Valparaiso Church of Christ and Green Oaks Valparaiso. Exhibit 'A' is the recently approved Valparaiso Redevelopment Commission allocation area for West St. Said West St. corridor is approximately 7,000 feet in length or 1.3 miles. The corridor study shall include Marsh St. from U.S. Hwy 30 to West St. Said Marsh St corridor being approximately 300 feet in length.

<u>Scope</u>: The attached Exhibit 'B' displays the location of the proposed project area. The scope of the engineering and planning study shall be:

- Reviewing and analyzing the existing site, existing site topography and site infrastructure.
- Reviewing existing and future land uses surrounding the site. This shall include the U.S. Hwy. 30 corridor that is adjacent to the West St. project area.
- Based on future land uses, concepts for architectural character, streetscapes, and landscaping for the project area.
- Existing and future building locations with amenities.
- Pedestrian connectivity features; sidewalks, pathways, connections to the existing commercial developments along West St., Marsh St., and U.S. Hwy. 30. Sidewalk connections to the east then north along Campbell St. to connect to the downtown business district.
- Traffic study for West St. and Marsh St. based on existing conditions and after Journeyman build out and proposed future land uses. Proposals for West St. improvements based on scenarios for potential additional traffic or to keep traffic levels to a manageable level for West St.
- Red Flag Survey to determine environmentally, historical or other significant areas.
- Utility survey and mapping of existing utilities (underground and aerial)
  within the project area. Easements dedicated for the public utilities
  shall be shown on survey and mapping. Overhead facilities shall be
  evaluated, and recommendations provided if relocations are feasible.
- Conceptual plan renderings for discussion with City with probable costs or estimates for engineering, parcel acquisitions, construction, and construction engineering. Develop recommended typical road cross section.
- Two in-person meetings to discuss plan renderings and regular monthly reports in writing.
- Public presentation to the Valparaiso Redevelopment Commission with final plan renderings and draft report.
- Final report submitted to Valparaiso Redevelopment Commission
