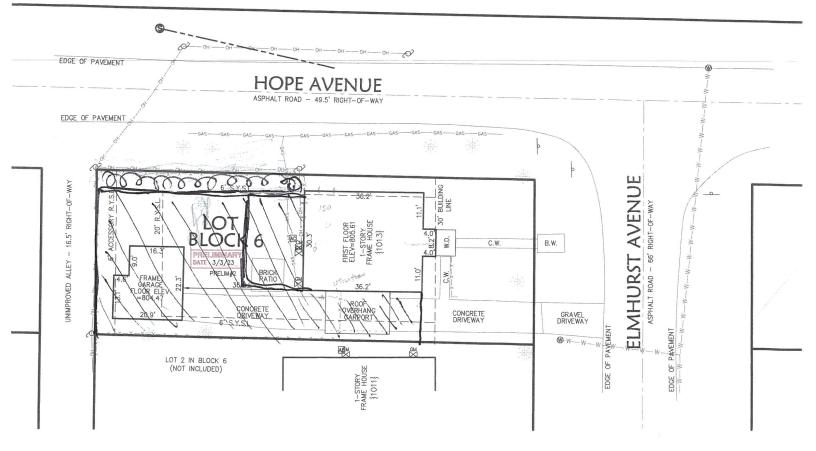
The petitioner carries the burden of proving to the Board of Zoning Appeals the existence of each and every one of the elements listed above.

- A. The proposed variance from the Development Standards will not be injurious to the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the community because:
- Traffic and Line of Sight: The proposed fence will not impede traffic flow or obstruct sightlines for drivers, pedestrians, or cyclists. The placement and height of the fence, although different from the previous fencing, have been designed to ensure that it does not interfere with visibility, preserving safe driving and pedestrian conditions on Hope Street for all.
- 2. **Beautification and Low Maintenance**: The new fence has been selected with an emphasis on enhancing the aesthetics of the area. Its design and materials are intended to improve the visual appeal of the surrounding environment, contributing positively to the neighborhood's overall appearance and character. Furthermore, a fencing of this type requires little to no upkeep and maintenance which is critical given our limited ability to physically maintain something that needs manual labor in order to maintain.
- 3. Preservation of Useable Space: The installation of the new fence does not reduce or interfere with the usable space available for the community. We only wish to replace the new fence material in the exact location of the current fence and can ensure that it does not obstruct common areas or limit access to any public spaces.
- B. The use and value of the area adjacent to the property included in the proposed variance will not be affected in a substantially adverse manner because:
  - The adjacent property is characterized by a sloped hill, which reduces the impact of the proposed fence on the neighboring area.
  - The area surrounding the property lacks sidewalks, and as such, there is minimal to no foot traffic in the immediate vicinity. With no regular pedestrian activity or pathways around the neighborhood, the fence will not interfere with the movement of residents or visitors of any neighbors or adjacent property.
  - Other properties in the neighborhood that have fences facing the road feature similar fence heights. The proposed fence will align with the established character of the area, ensuring that it does not create an inconsistency that would affect the aesthetic appeal or value of adjacent properties.

- C. The strict application of the terms of the zoning ordinance will result in practical difficulties in the use of the property included in the proposed variance because:
- Strict adherence to the zoning ordinance would require a setback that would result in the loss of approximately 200 square yards of valuable green space. This area is essential for landscaping, outdoor activities, and overall aesthetic appeal, and its reduction would significantly impact the livability and functionality of the property.
- Applying the zoning ordinance as it stands would place the fence too close to the house, making it more difficult to access and maintain. Leaving the fence in the current location would maintain extra space between the fence and the house preventing events such as vandalism which unfortunately we have experienced. A change of location would decrease the functionality of the area around the house particularly for routine activities such as maintenance, landscaping, and general use of the space.



Privacy Fence Location Per UDO



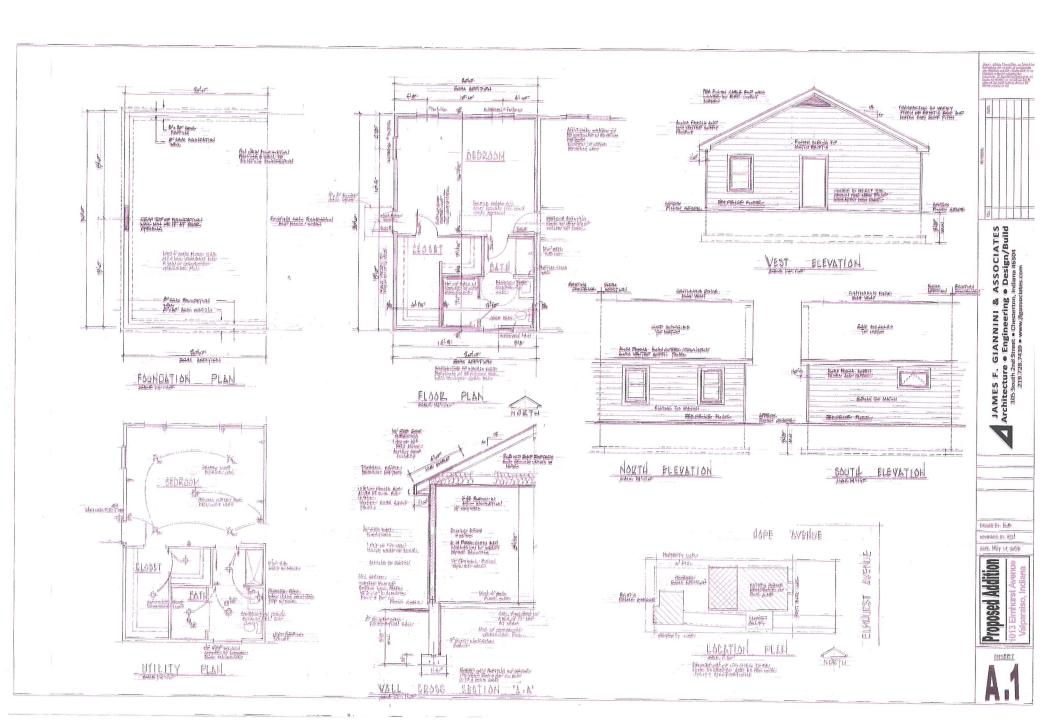

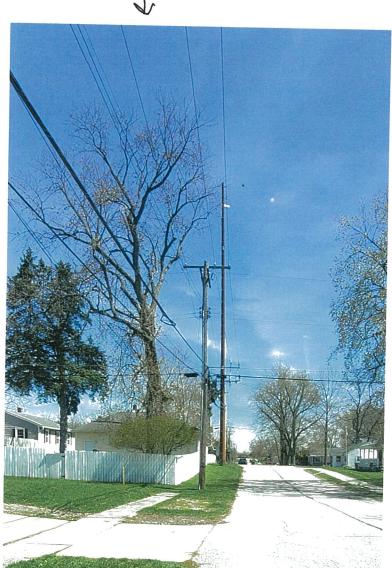

(INL) District.

Case No.:

The above-named Petitioner now makes the proposed Findings of Fact in support of Petitioner's petition for a variance of use to allow a facility for development of sports skills, fundamental athletic movements and athletic coaching and shall include a studio for golf simulators, batting cages, weight training and other athletic development methods on the above described real estate. After conducting a public hearing pursuant to I.C. 37-7-4-920 *et seq.* and the Unified Development Ordinance, and after hearing Petitioner's arguments and evidence in support of the variance, remonstrance and opposition or the opportunity for the receipt thereof, and comments, reports or recommendations of staff and others, the Board of Zoning Appeals for the City of Valparaiso, Indiana now finds:

#### FINDINGS:

- 1. The grant will not be injurious to the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the community because:
  - a. The granting of the variance will not adversely affect the safety of vehicular traffic by reducing or obstructing the line of sight at intersections of public or private roads or driveways. Traffic volume is consistent with or lower impact from many light industrial uses otherwise permitted. The vision is unobstructed both east and west. There are no hills or valleys in the road to limit visibility of on oncoming traffic or to obstruct the view of entering vehicles.
  - b. The granting of the variance will not restrict or hamper access by emergency apparatus or personnel to the proposed structure or any other structure.
  - c. The proposed facility promotes participation in athletic activity and enhances physical fitness of the participants and students.
- 2. The use and value of the area adjacent to the property included in the variance will not be affected in a substantially adverse manner because:
  - a. The granting of the variance will not substantially increase noise, light, traffic, drainage or other development standards.
  - b. The granting of the variance and allowance of the proposed use does not impair public safety, harm community character, or jeopardize the protection of public infrastructure, and land use compatibility.
  - c. The granting of the variance is the most restrictive and the minimum relief available to the Petitioner.
- 3. The need for the variance arises from some condition peculiar to the property involved because:
  - a. The Petitioner's property is of sufficient size to accommodate the proposed use without negative impacts to the surrounding property. The building improvements and divided leasable space provide special use advantages for the utilization of sports performance training systems where flight and trajectory of the flight of a ball in play can allow performance feedback in an indoor climate-controlled environment.
  - b. The subject property contains a commercial/industrial building which Petitioner leases to various tenants. A portion of the building is currently

- vacant and underutilized, and the proposed use of the structure is a good use of existing resources.
- c. Section 1.415 of the UDO acknowledges that the character of buildings within the Industrial, Light (INL) District are generally utilitarian and the overall building is adequately and strategically designed to allow for varying uses in the building.
- d. The building is located near and has easy access to State Highway 49, a major thoroughfare that can easily accommodate traffic for this use.
- 4. The strict application of the terms of the zoning ordinance will constitute an unnecessary hardship if applied to the property for which the variance is sought because:
  - a. The granting of the variance will allow the Petitioner's property to be used in the best practical way without frustrating or infringing on the use or enjoyment of neighboring properties. Petitioner's real estate and the building situated thereon is uniquely configured in generally a lineal orientation with acoustic building materials designed for Light Industrial uses thereby controlling the transmission of sound to adjoining properties or other tenants.
  - b. The need for the use variance is not self-created or inflicted and is not the result of actions or omissions of the Petitioner.
  - c. The Unified Development Ordinance does not provide a district or classification to provide the Petitioner with the proposed use and Petitioner would have to rely on Section 2.204 (Unlisted and Functionally Similar Uses) for allowance of this use in potentially other zoning districts.
- 5. The approval does not interfere substantially with the comprehensive plan because:
  - a. The granting of the variance will not alter the essential character of the locality and will provide for the orderly growth and development of the area because the use is permitted in commercial zoning classifications that offer a lesser intensity of use under the Unified Development Ordinance.
  - b. The granting of the variance does not alter or negatively affect the community character, historic neighborhoods, or other key growth factors discussed in the Comprehensive Plan. The proposed use is consistent with and does not deviate from the auto-urban character of the overall development.
  - c. Access to and enjoyment of all abutting property is not made difficult or frustrated by the granting of the variance.

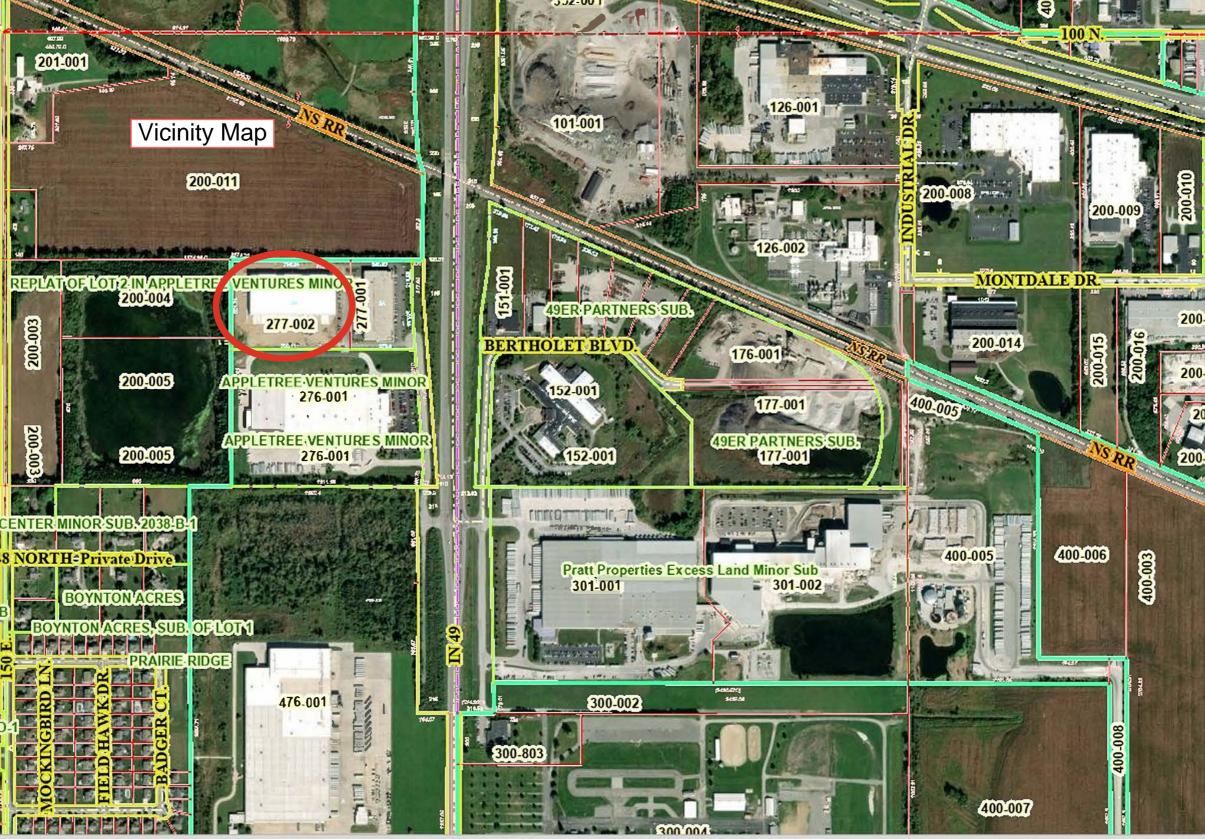

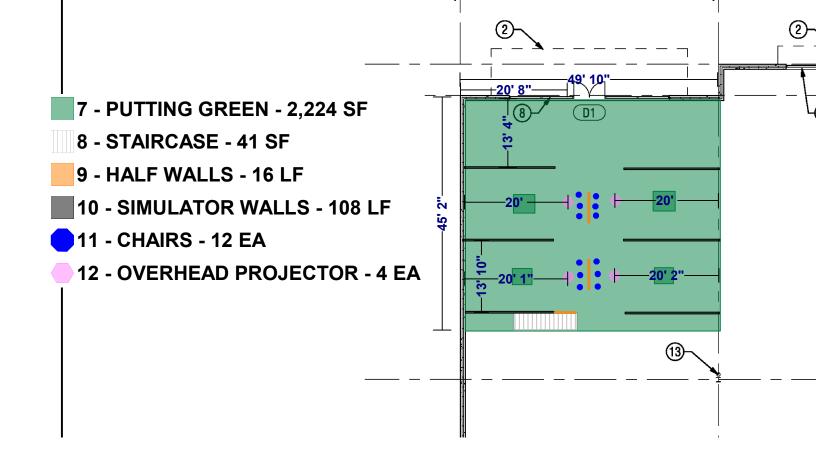
