

SR 130 to Temporarily Close for Railroad Improvement

Beginning Sept. 28, 2020, the Canadian National (CN) railroad crossing at SR 130 will be closed for approximately two weeks as CN works to improve the railroad crossing. This crossing is located between CR 375 N and Froberg Road and a detour will divert traffic to Joliet Road and CR 250W (Tower Road).

“This crossing has been in poor condition for some time and was scheduled for replacement next year. However, we’ve worked with CN to accelerate this repair and look forward to improvements for motorists very soon,” said Mayor Matt Murphy.

The City of Valparaiso’s Engineering Department and Public Works staff have developed the detour route for the temporary closure and coordinated with the Porter County Highway Department, since the official detour route makes use of County roads.
