Holiday Schedule 2010**

To simplify garbage and recycling pickup schedules, we provide the following guidelines for your convenience.

- On all holidays falling on the first four days of the work week (Monday through Thursday), we will be off that day and resume service the following day. All pickups following the holiday will be delayed one day with the exception of Friday's recycling pickup which will remain on Friday. Any day before the holiday that week will have pickups as normally scheduled. If the holiday falls on a Sunday, it will be observed Monday and scheduling will be adjusted as noted above.
- If the holiday falls on a Friday or Saturday, the holiday will be observed on Friday and all of Friday's scheduled pickups will be picked up one day earlier, on Thursday.

**HOLIDAY CLEANOUT WEEKS**

All observed holidays are followed by "Holiday Cleanout Weeks" with an additional "Spring Cleanout Week" following Easter Sunday. "Cleanout Weeks" are an opportunity for residents to place up to 3 cubic yards of extra trash *on your designated day* during Cleanout Week—at no additional charge.
