## Resolution No. <u>06</u> - 2020

## Resolution of the Valparaiso Redevelopment Commission establishing a nonvoting advisor

Whereas, the Valparaiso Redevelopment Commission ("Commission") is a governmental entity established under Indiana Code § 36-7-14 et seq;

Whereas, as provided under Indiana Code § 36-7-14-6.1, the Commission is comprised of five (5) members plus one (1) nonvoting advisor;

Whereas, the Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the Commission and the Valparaiso community to include a second nonvoting advisor commencing January 1, 2021;

Wherefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Valparaiso Redevelopment Commission as follows:

- 1. At the regularly scheduled December Commission meeting, the Commission may recommend to the Mayor the appointment of a nonvoting advisor. The recommendation must be unanimous and must include the favorable recommendation of the nonvoting advisor appointed under Indiana Code § 36-7-14-6.1(d).
- 2. The recommended advisor must be a resident of Center Township and preferably a resident outside the corporate limits of Valparaiso.
- 3. If the Mayor accepts the recommendation of the Commission, the person recommended shall serve in a matter substantially similar to the nonvoting advisor appointed under Indiana Code § 36-7-14-6.1(d) except that the term shall expire on December 31 of the year of the appointment. The nonvoting advisor shall not be entitled to compensation for his/her service. The Commission may recommend to the Mayor the appointment of a nonvoting advisor in succeeding years in the manner provided in Section 1.
- 4. At the discretion of the Commission President, the nonvoting advisor authorized under this Resolution may be barred from receiving certain information and/or participating in certain Commission discussions, if the Commission President reasonably believes that such inclusion of the nonvoting advisor could create a potential conflict under the Access to Public Records Act, Open Door Law, and/or any other applicable law.
- 5. Nothing in this Resolution shall impact the nonvoting advisor appointed under Indiana Code § 36-7-14-6.1(d).
- 6. For purposes of attending Executive Sessions, the nonvoting advisor shall be considered necessary to carry out the purpose of the Executive Session as allowed under Indiana Code § 5-14-1.5-2(f).

- 7. At any time, the Mayor and/or Commission President may rescind the appointment of the nonvoting advisor.
- 8. This Resolution shall expire on December 31 of any given year unless extended by the Commission by its unanimous recommendation of a nonvoting advisor to serve the following year.
