

RESOLUTION No. 1, 2023

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF WORKS AND PUBLIC SAFETY CONCERNING  
RECYCLING**

**WHEREAS**, on **September 12, 2022**, the City Council adopted Ordinance 19-2022 amending Section 53 of the Valparaiso Municipal Code concerning the regulation of Refuse and Recycling within the City of Valparaiso.

**WHEREAS**, Section 53.02 provides that the City's Board of Public Works and Safety is empowered to promulgate rules and regulations as to the implementation of the ordinance.

**WHEREAS**, Section 53.03 provides that the Executive Director of the Public Works Division is responsible for administration of the ordinance.

**WHEREAS**, one change to the City's recycling program was the limiting of residential recycling pickup to every other week.

**WHEREAS**, to mitigate the impact to residents, it has been the recommendation of the Executive Director of the Public Works Division that residents that request a second recycling tote would receive a second tote. The cost of the second tote (\$14.65) would be waived through **December 31, 2023**.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Works accepts this recommendation.

**WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** as follows:


1. The Board of Works authorizes and directs the Executive Director of the Public Works Division to offer residential customers of the City's refuse and recycling services the option to receive a second recycling tote at no additional charge through **December 31, 2023**.
2. The Executive Director of the Public Works Division is empowered to further modify and/or extend this accommodation without further action of the Board of Works.


