
Neighborhood Improvement Grant 2019 Funding Recommendations

The Neighborhood Improvement Grant allows neighborhood groups to apply for grants up to \$15,000 for physical improvement projects. During the 2019 application period (April 18 – September 20), 14 neighborhoods applied for funding with requests totaling \$153,255. The Grant Review Committee discussed all applications and considered funding based on criteria from the Grant Review Checklist and recommends awarding \$132,570. Below you will find the Committee's funding recommendations a map of where future projects will take place throughout the city.
