

Valparaiso to Reopen City Hall

The City of Valparaiso will reopen City Hall to the public beginning Monday, Aug. 10, announced Mayor Matt Murphy. “While all of our operations have continued seamlessly during the COVID-19 pandemic and we have continued to serve the community from City Hall, we’re now ready to welcome the public to our spaces with appropriate precautions in place,” said Murphy. “For those who have enjoyed the convenience of online, mail and phone service, we continue to offer those options and encourage their use,” he said.

Beginning Monday, Aug. 10, the public may enter Valparaiso’s City Hall through the entrance located on the building’s Napoleon Street side only, which will be open Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. Facial coverings will be required for all visitors. Valparaiso City Hall is located at 166 Lincolnway and houses the offices for the departments of Building, Clerk-Treasurer, Community Engagement, Economic Development, Planning, Human Resources and the Mayor’s office.
