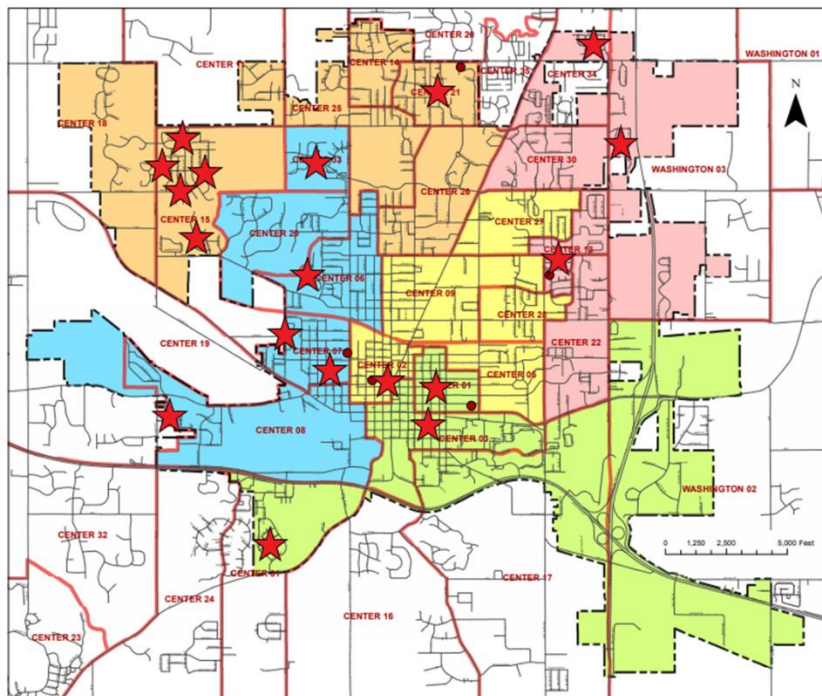


2020 Neighborhood Improvement Grant Funding Summary

The Neighborhood Improvement Grant allows neighborhood groups to apply for grants up to \$15,000 for physical improvement projects. During the 2020 application period, 18 neighborhoods applied for funding with requests totaling \$183,209. The Grant Review Committee discussed all applications and considered funding based on criteria from the Grant Review Checklist and recommends awarding \$132,000. Below you will find the Committee's funding recommendations and a map of where future projects will take place.
