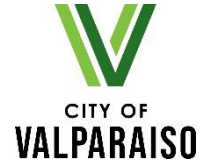

- Does the primary city department have the capacity to complete this project in the next year?

### Neighborhood Investment

- Is the neighborhood providing additional funding towards the project?
- Is the neighborhood volunteering time and labor to complete the project?
- Is the neighborhood volunteering time and labor to maintain the project over time?

### Community Benefit

- Do residents beyond the neighborhood boundaries benefit from the project?
- Does this project enhance the sense of community for residents?
