

## City of Valparaiso Seeks Nominations for Good Neighbor Award

The City of Valparaiso is seeking nominations for its annual Good Neighbor Recognition, launched in 2020 to highlight an individual who demonstrates exemplary commitment to their neighborhood and the greater community through volunteerism and service. "The Good Neighbor Award is one way we can recognize people who are engaged in Valparaiso and doing extraordinary things in our community," said Mayor Matt Murphy. The only qualification is that nominees must reside and primarily perform their volunteer service within the City of Valparaiso. Nominations are due by Nov. 3 to be considered for the 2023 award.
