In addition to leading Valpo Parks, Nuppnau is active in other community organizations, such as PALS (Professionals Advancing Local Success) which partners with the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Northwest Indiana. He also serves on the board of the Valparaiso Community Schools Foundation and was recently recognized by *The Times of Northwest Indiana* as one of "20 Under 40" for his accomplishments and leadership.
